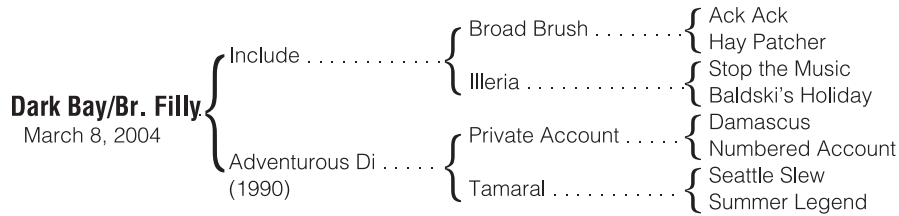

By **INCLUDE (1997)**, black type winner of 10 races, \$1,659,560, Pimlico Special H. [G1], New Orleans H. [G2], Massachusetts H. [G2], Whirlaway H., Vincent A. Moscarelli Memorial S., Jennings H. twice, 2nd Clark H. [G2], 3rd Suburban H. [G2], Massachusetts H. [G2], Meadowslands Cup H. [G2]. His first foals are yearlings of 2005.

**Include/Adventurous Di 2004 dark bay or brown filly**

Conformation Notes:

Well grown, strong, muscular, attractive filly; beautiful head and eye with tremendous presence and elegance; strong, mature bodied filly with a powerful, muscular hip and quarter; great balance and quality; medium bone; very slightly back at the knee, turns in a little left front; excellent mover, very racey looking. 8R

This filly is from the first crop of the outstanding racehorse and promising freshman sire Include. Include was a versatile and durable racehorse, winning ten of his twenty lifetime starts for career earnings of \$1,659,560. He was noted for his courage, soundness, consistency and durability. He competed at the highest level in stakes races all over the country, many times giving considerable weight to his opponents. He was a model of consistency, very similar to his sire Broad Brush. Include was popular with breeders as he is a complete outcross from the Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector bloodlines. His first crop was well received at the yearling sales and sold extremely well, averaging \$124,605, ten times his initial stud fee of \$12,500. Based on the yearlings we have seen so far, it appears that Include is producing better looking stock than his sire Broad Brush, whose offspring typically are plain, ordinary-looking horses. The Include yearlings are mature, well-muscled, nicely balanced, forward-looking individual, who should run as two-year-olds and be able to stretch out two turns. This is a very mature, forward, athletic, racey looking filly who just glides over the ground effortlessly. She has plenty of substance and quality and will be impressive when she is training fit. She will be well suited for the Fasig-Tipton Calder Sale.
