

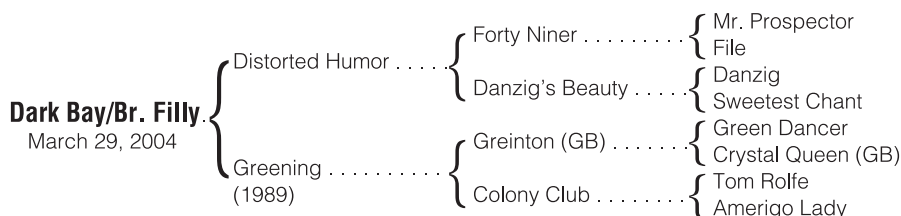

Distorted Humor/Greening 2004 dark bay or brown filly

Conformation Notes:

Big, tall, rangy, solid, attractive filly; lovely head and eye with a beautiful neck and shoulder; super bodied filly with a massive hip and quarter; hocks a little bent, front feet slightly narrow; correct, tracks well, excellent mover; very racey looking. 8R

This is a big, rangy, impressive filly with a lot of scope and substance by the tremendously successful sire Distorted Humor. Distorted Humor has had an incredible year in 2005, siring 14 individual stakes winners. He currently ranks fourth on the General Sires List ahead of many of the top sires such as Giant's Causeway, Storm Cat, Kingmambo and Seeking the Gold. The Distorted Humor offspring are noted for their versatility, durability, courage and soundness, which is why they are so successful on the racetrack and why they are in such high demand at the yearling sales. An interesting observation that I have noted is the fact that Distorted Humor's yearlings come in all different shapes, makes, sizes and colors. There does not seem to be any strict pattern, continuity or uniformity among his offspring. They are multi dimensional on the racetrack; they can sprint and run successfully as two-year-olds and carry their speed two turns to be successful at the highest level as three-year-olds and older horses. Among his top runners are Funny Cide, winner of the Kentucky Derby and Preakness with earnings of \$3,216,985, and Flower Alley, winner of the Travers G1 and the Jim Dandy Stakes G2 with career earnings thus far of \$1,501,660. This filly is out of the very successful runner and stakes producer Greening, who has already produced two graded stakes winners, Turnofthecentury (c by Holy Bull), a Grade 2 winner of \$474,236, and Best Friend Stro (f by Jade Hunter) winner of the Busher Stakes G3 and 3rd in the CCA Oaks G1 with earnings of \$196,479. This filly is from the Mr. Prospector line as Distorted Humor's grandsire is Mr. Prospector, which is significant when one considers that two of her stakes winning/placed half siblings also have Mr. Prospector as their paternal grandsire. She has plenty of size, substance, power and quality and should finish out into a really impressive individual when racing fit. Additionally, she is a registered New York-bred, which is definitely a plus and very desirable. She will be pointed to either the Fasig-Tipton Calder or Keeneland April Sale.
