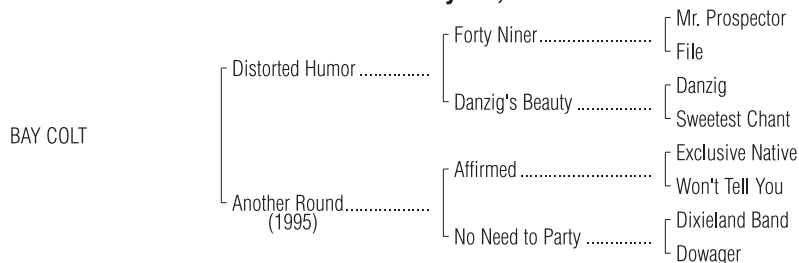

Distorted Humor/Another Round 2005 bay colt

Very well-grown, smooth, strong, handsome colt; tremendous head and eye with great presence and outlook; beautiful bodied colt with good balance and quality; right knee rotates a little; turns out slightly right front; a little long and soft in the pasterns; carries tremendous condition; super mover. 8

This is a very strong, mature, well-developed colt by the immensely successful sire Distorted Humor. He has remarkable size, strength, and substance considering he is a May 15th foal. He is a very solid colt who carries plenty of condition, and will be an awesome individual when he is racing fit. Distorted Humor is having another outstanding year in 2006. He currently ranks 7th on the 2006 Leading Sires List, with progeny earnings of \$5,186,329. He is the leading sire by number of individual stakes winners (18) which, as a group, have won 23 stakes races. He has sired eight graded stakes winners in 2006, which ties him for first place with Giant's Causeway. Each of his eighteen stakes winners in 2006 has a different broodmare sire – a testament to the dominance of Distorted Humor in his offspring. Regardless of who he is bred to, he improves his mares across the board. He is extremely popular with owners and trainers as his offspring are versatile, sound, courageous, and competitive. As a sire, he is the complete package as evidenced by the versatility of his offspring. Due to his tremendous success on the racetrack, his stud fee rose from \$60,000 in 2005 to \$150,000 in 2006 and it is speculated that he will perhaps stand for in excess of \$200,000 in 2007. Distorted Humor's stakes winners are numerous; his 2006 stakes winners include Funny Cide G1 (\$3,435,128), Flower Alley G1 (\$2,533,910), and Commentator G1 (\$751,246). This is a stylish, handsome colt who will continue to mature and develop during the next several months. We expect him to finish out into an exceptional two-year-old. As he is a May foal, we will give him plenty of time and probably point him to the Keeneland April sale.
