More Than Ready/Lady In Power 2005 dark bay or brown filly

Big, tall, strong, deep, powerful, rangy filly; lovely head and eye with a kind, honest outlook; nice long neck with a beautiful deep shoulder and girth; very deep and strong through the barrel; super-bodied filly with tremendous hip and quarter; turns out slightly right front; clean, sound, correct, tracks well; very powerful, athletic mover. 8

This is a big, strong, mature, solid filly by the outstanding young sire More Than Ready. This filly has plenty of height, length, scope, and substance, which is unusual for a More Than Ready offspring. Many of the More Than Ready's are medium-sized, well-balanced, typey horses but this filly gets her size, strength, and substance from her maternal grandsire, Fappiano, whom she strongly favors. She is beautifully balanced and has tremendous quality, which complements her size and strength. More Than Ready has had another incredible year in 2006, with thirteen individual stakes winners who, combined, have won twenty stakes races. We have had great success in the past with More Than Ready fillies, including Ready To Please (More Than Ready/Guilty Pleasure 2003 filly), winner of the Fantasy Stakes G2 in 2006 (current earnings \$276,522). She was bought by Jim Scatuorchio for \$270,000 at the 2005 OBS February Two-Year-Olds-In-Training sale. We also sold La Chunga (More Than Ready/Gypsy Monarch 2003 filly), a multiple Grade 3 winner in England in 2005 and 2006, for \$270,000 to Sir Robert Ogden at the 2005 Fasig-Tipton Calder sale. This filly is out of Lady In Power, a versatile runner, winning on both dirt and turf as a three-year-old. Lady In Power's second dam is the great mare Lady Winborne, who was a wonderful foundation mare for Diane and Peter Perkins' Wimborne Farm. Lady Winborne produced five stakes winners, including two Grade 1 winners, Al Mamoon and La Gueriere. This is a classic-type filly who will be at her optimum running two turns. She will probably be pointed to the Fasig-Tipton Calder sale.
