Aldebaran/Look for Good 2005 dark bay or brown colt

Average-sized, strong, deep, solid, robust colt; mature head and eye with a great presence and a masculine outlook; very strong through the neck, chest, and shoulder with a deep heart girth and rib; strong, muscular back with a well-developed hip and quarter; tremendous forearm and gaskin; left knee slightly in, toes out a little left front, naturally athletic mover; real two-year-old. 8R

This is a well-made, sturdy, powerful colt from the first crop of the exciting freshman yearling sire Aldebaran. He was a little immature when purchased at the Fasig-Tipton July sale, but has since matured, strengthened, and muscled up through the body. The first crop of yearlings by Aldebaran were well-received by the buyers. As a four-year-old, Aldebaran ran second in such prestigious races as the Metropolitan Handicap G1, the Cigar Mile H. G1, and the Vosburgh H. G1. In 2003 (his five-year-old season) Aldebaran was Champion Sprinter and won several Grade One races, including the Metropolitan Handicap G1, the Forego H. G1, and the San Carlos H. G1. He competed with and defeated many outstanding racehorses in his career including Affirmed Success G1, Left Bank G1, Congaree G1, Harlan's Holiday G1, Proud Citizen G2, and Gygistar G1. This colt is out of Look for Good, a winning Unbridled's Song mare, who is half-sister to Nonproductiveasset, a multiple stakes winner and Grade 1 stakes-placed winner of \$491,439. This colt looks a lot like Aldebaran, but bears an even more striking resemblance to Aldebaran's sire, Mr. Prospector, which is not surprising as he is inbred 2x4 to him. This colt has a lot of class and a wonderful mind and attitude. We really like this colt and believe he has the potential to be a very good two-year-old. He will be pointed to the Fasig-Tipton Calder sale.
